625ILCS REGULATIONS STATE, IN PART, THE FOLLOWING:

(625 ILCS 5/13-109) **SAFETY TESTS** – Contract carrier transporting employees in the course of their employment on a highway of this state, shall be subjected to the safety test provided for in Chapter 13 of this code. Tests shall be conducted at an official testing station within 6 months prior to the application for registration as provided for in this code. Subsequently each vehicle shall be subject to tests at least every 6 months...

(625 ILCS 5/8-101) **PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY** – It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate any motor vehicle along or upon any public street or highway in any incorporated city, town or village unless such person, firm or corporation has given, and there is in full force and effect and on file with the Secretary of State of Illinois, proof of financial responsibility provided in this actaora

(625 ILCS 5/8-114) ISSUANCE OF LICENSE UPON PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPNSIBILITY – The Secretary of State shall issue to each person who has in effect proof of financial responsibility as required by Section 8-101 or 8-101.1, a certificate for each motor vehicle operated by such person and included within the proof of financial responsibility.

(625 ILCS 5/8-115 **DISPLAY OF CERTIFICATE-ENFORCEMENT** – The certificate issued pursuant to Section 8-114 shall be displayed upon a window of the motor vehicle for which it was issued, in such a manner as to be visible to the passengers carried therein. This Section and Section 8-114 shall be enforced by the State Police, the Secretary of State, and other police....

(625 ILCS 5/18c-4701 **INSIGNIA ON VEHICLES** – License and registration number of the vehicle must be displayed in such a manner as to be clearly legible and visible from both sides of the vehicle at a distance of 25 feet, when the vehicle is not in motion, and in accordance with such specifications as the

- Displayed in plain sight of passengers.
- Must have current month sticker affixed, month sticker alone is not proof of coverage.
- Information on back must match vehicle.

SAFETY INSP. STICKER



(background color will vary)

- Displayed on windshield in front of steering wheel, facing outward.
- Good for six (6) months.
- In effect until last day of month shown.

If the cab is licensed in another state, ie:
Michigan, Iowa, Minnesota, Indiana, etc,
it must have a D.O.T. Number displayed
on the vehicle where it can be clearly seen.
If there is no D.O.T. Number, it cannot
transport passengers in the state of Illinois.

Minimum tread depth for tires is 1/8 inch. Take a Lincoln penny, insert Lincoln's head into the tread. If you can see all of Lincoln's forehead, the tire is unsafe for I.L.C.S. 5/12-405.
